


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Investment Realization Quarter I 2014 Compared to The Same Periode in 2013: DDI and FDI; Java and Outside Java











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
FDI Trends by Country of Origin (Top 5): 2010 – March 2014

















Economic Corridor



Indonesian Labor Absorption Progress 2010 – March 2014: *Per Quarter*






Progress of Investment Realization 2010 – March 2014 : *Per Quarter*





Progress of Investment Realization of FDI 2010 – March 2014 in US Dollar : *Per Quarter*






